Message From the Co-Chairs

We are pleased to invite you to partner with us on for the next Fire Safety and Emergency Preparedness (FSEP) for the Nuclear Industry Conference. The venue selected for this event is the Hilton Fallsview Hotel which overlooks both the Canadian and American falls and is within walking distance of the falls and other major attractions including the Fallsview Casino's Entertainment Centre and Galleria Shops & Dining. The Venue is within 130 KM from Toronto International Airport (YYZ), 45 KM from Buffalo Niagara International Airport (BUF) and 20 KM from Niagara Falls International Airport (IAG).

Conference Objective

Building upon the success of FSEP 2019, held in Ottawa, Ontario, in October of that year, FSEP 2023 is being constructed with Sponsors and Exhibitors in mind. The previous conferences were supported by prominent organizations within the nuclear community and have attracted representatives from Canada, USA, India, Germany, Korea, UK, and Romania.

This 2.5-day conference will focus on the latest work and information in the key areas of fire safety and emergency preparedness. Substantial changes have been made to the Canadian and International safety codes, standards, guidelines, and technical tools relating to fire protection and emergency preparedness worldwide. This forum provides an opportunity to discuss these advances in the interest of improving fire safety and emergency preparedness in both new and operating nuclear power plants (NPPs), as well as Small Modular Reactors, research facilities, decommissioned facilities, uranium production and mining facilities.

The FSEP 2023 Conference will emphasize the sharing and exchange of information between the nuclear industry, fire protection and emergency preparedness specialists, suppliers and service providers, government representatives and officials, regulators, fire protection and Emergency Preparedness students and other stakeholders in fire protection and emergency management in the nuclear industry.

This premier international event is expected to attract a diverse audience of over one hundred specialists from Canada, the US and abroad, with over fifty plenary and technical presentations. 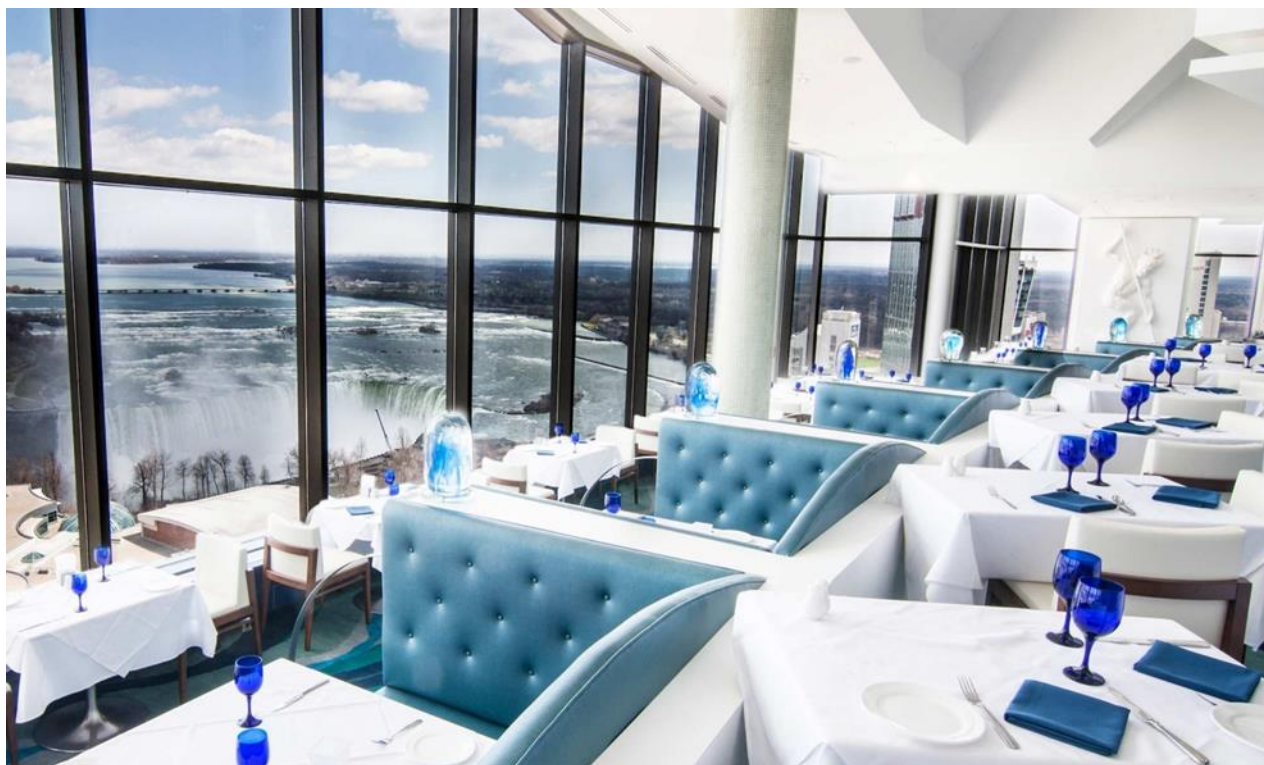
