MEMORANDUM FROM: L. Kowarski

TO: A.N. Budden

Re:- Shipment of Polymer from Montreal to Chalk River, Ontario

Our present programme for starting operations with the Z.E.E.P. requires that no time should be lost in transferring the 7600 lbs. of polymer at present used by Dr. Sargent's group. It is understood:

- a) That five drums (total net weight: about 2000 lbs.) can be shipped every day by the 10.15 p.m. train, except on Saturdays and Sundays.
- b) That the first five drums will be available for shipment on Thursday, August 30th, unless an unforeseen delay occurs in Dr. Sargent's experimental programme.

It is proposed that all preparations should be made, and every endeavour should be used, in order to be ready for starting the transfer on August 30th, according to the following schedule:

It is further understood:

- 1) That this programme may have to be changed in accordance with Dr. Sargent's requirements, and that the decision as to the first shipment will be made by Dr. Sargent on August 29th;
- 2) That it will be possible to make a shipment on Labour Day;
- 3) That appropriate arrangements will be made with D.I.L. (not N.R.C.) staff for taking over at Chalk River station.
- 4) That every drum will be sampled by Dr. Miller before shipment, sampling to be arranged by Dr. Sargent.
