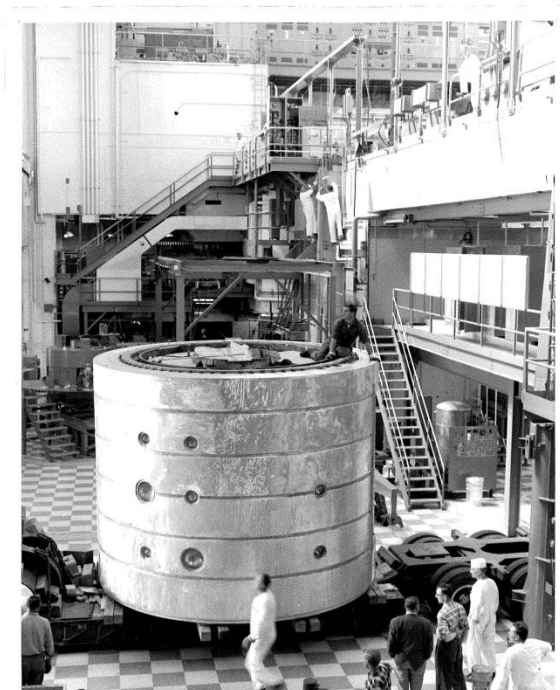




Annual General Meeting & Shad Valley Enrichment Program & 1972 NRU Vessel Change (movie)
