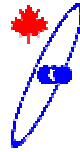

The NRU Reactor at AECL's Chalk River Laboratories has been a star performer for AECL, Canada and the world for close to 50 years. During that time it has hosted experiments to develop Canada's CANDU reactors, produced isotopes used in millions of medical treatments around the world, and its neutrons have allowed researchers to make major advances in science and materials.

Looking at a continued need for research facilities the next few years, AECL has launched the NRU Licensability Extension program to allow NRU to continue operating safely and reliably to at least 2012.
